Each number is the scary nation as you can see this channel called dark five produces scary videos. They have over 2.5 million subscribers and they produce videos like the five most mysterious photos for energize countdown list of different scary, mysterious subjects, and people are definitely interested in it and they can get a lot of use and now in order to give you as much value as I possibly can I'm going to reveal a list of high CPM niches these are niches that make more money on average per thousand views so if you wanna make more per thousand views, you can consider any of these niches that I'm showing you on the screen right now these are higher than average CPM niches at this point if you're ready to start your very own faceless niche channel you have two options option number one is to learn through trial and error guessing what will work and what won't work or option number two is getting help and guidance along the way from someone who's already done this process and helped tons of other people as well.
